Everyday 4000 per lakh people die in India due to cardiac arrest 90 percent out of these are out of hospital cardiac arrest. 70 percent can be saved if CPR is given in initial 4 mins. Every min delay in CPR reduces the chances of survival by 10 percent. Keeping these facts in mind this training was organised to spread awareness among the students n train them to provide timely CPR. hands on training were given to the students by Dr Jaya Lalwani (Professor Pt JNMC Medical College), Dr Anil Dubey (HOD Dept. of Paediatric Surgery Shri Balaji Medical College), Dr Neerja Agrawal (HOD Dept of Obs/ Gynae SBIMS), Dr Reema Wadhawa (Assoc Prof Dept of Anaesthesiology), SBIMS, Dr Hemali Doshi (assistant professor) SBIMS, Dr Sadia Shakeel (senior resident) SBIMS and Dr Swapnil Bhirange (Associate Professor) SBIMS. All the trainees were given certificate by Indian resuscitation council federation (IRCF). A small skit was also performed by the students to raise awareness about the compression only life support and emphasis that every citizen is a life saver!</p>
