After this session, lunch break was declared which was followed by the inauguration of the effect of Tobacco products on Environment in Chhattisgarh Factsheet and taking Oath on this occasion under the guidance of Chairman Dr. Devendra Naik and Dr. Kamlesh Jain regarding not to consume any kind of Tobacco Products. Medical College Raipur & State Nodal Officer NTCP, C.G. also presented his topic "COTPA activity undergoing in Chhattisgarh". This session was chaired by Dr. Shalaka Mohire Professor Physiology and Dr. Sanat Sharma, Professor and HOD Pharmacology.

After finishing the scientific session it was the time for panel discussion on Tobacco cessation and the expert panelists were, **Dr. Neerja Agarwal** [Professor and Head Obs & Gynaecology and MEU Coordinator, SBIMS], Dr. **Kamlesh Jain** [Professor Community Medicine, Pt. JNM Medical College Raipur & State Nodal Officer NTCP C.G.], **Dr. Shilpa K. Jain** [Assistant Professor Government Dental College, Raipur C.G., National and State Trainer for the Tobacco Control Program], **Dr. Digvijay Singh**, [Assistant Professor, ENT, RIMS Raipur], **Dr. Sandeep Surin**, [Assistant Professor, Respiratory Medicine SBIMS] . The entire panel discussion was supervised and moderated by **Dr. Kiran Makade**, Prof & HOD Community Medicine. The program ended after the panel discussion with giving the vote of thanks by Dr. Manish A Prasad Associate Professor, Community Medicine.

At the starting of the CME pretest (Format attached) was filled up by the participants and at the end of the CME a post test (Format attached) was submitted by the participants along with a feedback form (Format attached). 











